### **Judges' Education Opportunities**

We are running an extra F-G Seminar in 2024 on Sunday 8 December to cater for some interest from new Judges and others who need to reaccredit. Any Judge or rider at any level can attend, or any person interested in learning more about the sport. Please RSVP if you would like to join us on the day, to: <a href="mailto:dressagejudge@equestriansa.com.au">dressagejudge@equestriansa.com.au</a>.

Helen Whittle (A level National Judge and Judge Educator) will be the presenter. This will be held at Cromwell Park, Verdun, from 9 am to 3.30 pm. Theory in the morning and demonstration horses in the afternoon. Please note that for this Seminar to count for new Judges, they should attend the whole day. (Limited catering, BYO lunch. BYO chair for the theory session).

The A / B / C Seminar carried over from 2024 will be held on Sunday 2 March 2025 at Cromwell Park (practical / discussions) and also on a date TBC in February for an online theory session. We are very pleased to welcome Ricky MacMillan back to SA for this Seminar. More details coming soon.

Planning for 2025 is underway and there will be an F / G Seminar held on Saturday 10 May with Sue Chandler (Vic, National A level, Judge Educator and Coach) as the Judge Educator. The venue is Cromwell Park face-to-face theory and practical; put this date in your diary.

Riders and spectators are welcome to attend any of the Judge Education Seminars. They are a great opportunity to learn what Judges can see and how marks are awarded.

### Judge Re-accreditation due in March 2025

A reminder to all Judges to start preparing your information for reaccreditation renewal in March 2025! The summary below was sent by EADOC and gives a guide to what you need to submit.

An ORBT test will also need to be completed. This will be available online in February 2025.

Compulsory Seminar - you must make sure that you attendance is recorded on the attendance sheet:

- **G to A** must have attended, **in this three year period for this reaccreditation only,** a Seminar at your level. However, to <u>maintain accreditation</u> G level Judges may attend any F Seminar and F level Judges may attend any G Seminar.
- Young Horse Judges must have attended, in this three year period only, a Young Horse Seminar.

- Para-Equestrian Judges must have attended, in this three year period only, a Para Dressage Seminar.
- Only Seminars approved by the JSC or EADOC will be recognized.

Compulsory Workshops - you must make sure that your attendance is recorded on the attendance sheet.

- Must have attended at least two within this three year period.
   These are considered professional development and educational activities and make you a better Judge. Additional Seminars may be substituted as a workshop.
- Only workshops approved by the State JSC or EADOCs will be recognized.

Judging - Official Competitive and Other Competitions - Judging required over this three year period.

- F to A level Judges you are required to judge six Official Competitive competitions at your judging level ie. F at Novice, E at Elementary, D at Medium, C at Advanced, B at PSG or Inter I, A at Inter A to GP.
- **G level Judges** you are required to judge at six competitions over this three year period Official Preliminary or Participation / Club at Preliminary / Novice level this can include Eventing dressage.
- Young Horse Judges judge at least one Young Horse competition.

**Note** - if you have upgraded during the re-accreditation period, please note this and this will be taken into consideration when assessing what you have judged at your highest level. Judging will be on a pro rate basis.

Judging - Other Competitions - Judging required over this three year period.

 F to A Judges - you are required to judge six other competitions at any level up to your highest level e.g. Official, Participation, AHRC, Eventing, Closed Restricted etc. See Rule 12.9 and the table synopsis.

Our Vice Chair and Clubs Representative, Julia Weir, has donated her time, advice, enthusiasm, governance and constitutional knowledge over the past sixteen years to help our membership.

"The Board of Equestrian South Australia (ESA) offers Julia Weir an unreserved apology for any hurt, distress, or damage to her reputation and coaching business, caused by action taken against her in April 2023 by the former Board of ESA.

One of a number of legacy matters inherited by the current Board, following the resignation of all Directors of ESA in May 2023, involved allegations against Mrs Weir made by the former Board.

After completing a thorough investigation, the current Board found that advice provided by Mrs Weir in relation to the conditions for an Office of Recreation, Sport and Racing grant was correct. The current board found the allegations made against Mrs Weir to be unsubstantiated.

Mrs Weir did not breach any policies or confidentiality agreements and had, at all times acted reasonably, professionally and responsibly in her engagement with both the former Chair of Dressage SA and the former ESA Board in relation to advice she provided."






