The vaulters leader board will be based on an individual's scores at competitions throughout the year.

Vaulters must compete in a minimum of 3 competitions to be eligible for the leader board.

The final scores of the class will be used.

The top 3 scores for the vaulter throughout the year will be averaged and the vaulter with the highest average will win.

Gender will not be split for any leader board awards.

Eligible competitions include all South Australian competitions, Australian Nationals and all Australian CVIs.

Junior Vaultler of the Year and Senior Vaultler of the Year awards will include Intermediate Individual, Advanced Individual, and Open Individual.

A weighting will be placed on vaulters' scores for junior and senior vaulter of the year.

Intermediate scores will incur a 0% weighting. Advanced will incur a 5% weighting, Open without a Technical Test will incur a 7.5% weighting, Open with a Technical Test will incur a 10% weighting.

Junior and Senior will be determined by age of the vaulter as at 1st January. Under 18 years old will be classed as Junior. 18 years and over will be classed as Senior.

To be eligible for the AWD award you must nominate that you are an AWD vaulter in the entries for a minimum of 3 competitions.



Vaulting SA Leader Board Rules



Horse Leader Board

- *Participant Horse of the Year*
- *Competitor Horse of the Year*

The horse leader board will be based on the horse's score at competitions.

The highest score for a complete class of the day is used.

The horse must compete in a minimum of 3 competitions to be eligible.

The top 3 scores from competitions throughout the year will be averaged and the horse with the highest average will win.

Horse scores can come from all participant or competitor classes including individual, pas de deux or squad. Recreational classes will not be included.

Eligible competitions include all South Australian competitions, Australian Nationals and all Australian CVIs.

The horse score can come from both South Australian vaulter or guest vaulter combinations (eg. Interstate/overseas vaulters).

Participant Horse of the Year will include classes from Preliminary, Pre-Novice, and Novice levels.

Competitor Horse of the Year will include classes from Intermediate, Advanced, and Open.

Volunteer of the Year Award

This award recognises an individual who contributes to the running of Vaulting in South Australia voluntarily. This person will have shown outstanding commitment to helping the sport throughout the year. Nominations for this award will be taken from the vaulting community and then put to a poll to determine the winner.

The following criteria should be considered for nominations:

- Level of contribution to the sport as a volunteer (eg. roles held, regular commitments, time devoted, etc)
- Evidence of dedication to the growth of vaulting in South Australia.
- Helping out at a variety of events throughout the year (both within individual clubs and vaulting community events)

Nominations for this award will be called in October each year and then a poll will be sent out to the South Australian Vaulting members to vote. Details of how to put forward nominations will be emailed to the community mailing list.
